Working with Children Check

Issue Date: December 2 017

The Working With Children Check (WWCC) is a requirement for people who work or volunteer in child related work. It involves a national criminal history check and a review of findings of workplace misconduct.

The result of a WWCC is either a clearance to work w ith children for five years, or a bar against working with children. Cleared applicants are subject to ongoing monitoring and relevant new records may lead to the clearance being revoked. The WWCC is fully portable and can be used for any paid or unpaid child-related work in NSW for as long as the worker remains cleared.

- The Catholic Schools Office (CSO) verifies employee Working with Children Checks clearances with the Office of Children's Guardian
- Zimmerman Services verifies Volunteer Working with Childre n Check clearances
